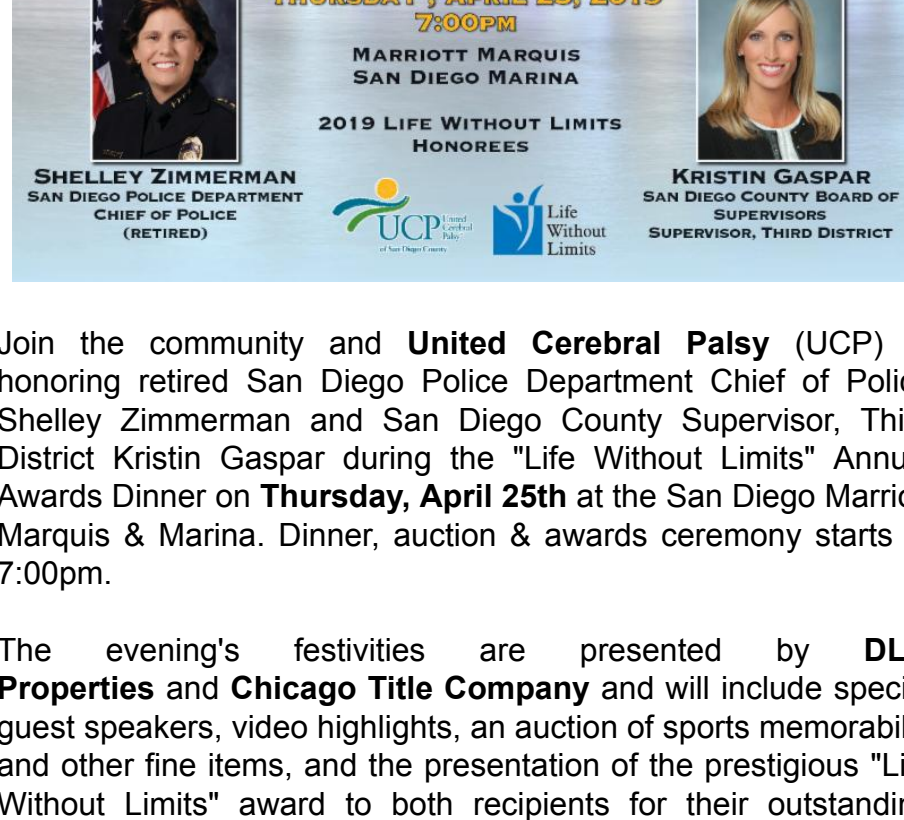

**"Life Without Limits" Awards Dinner**



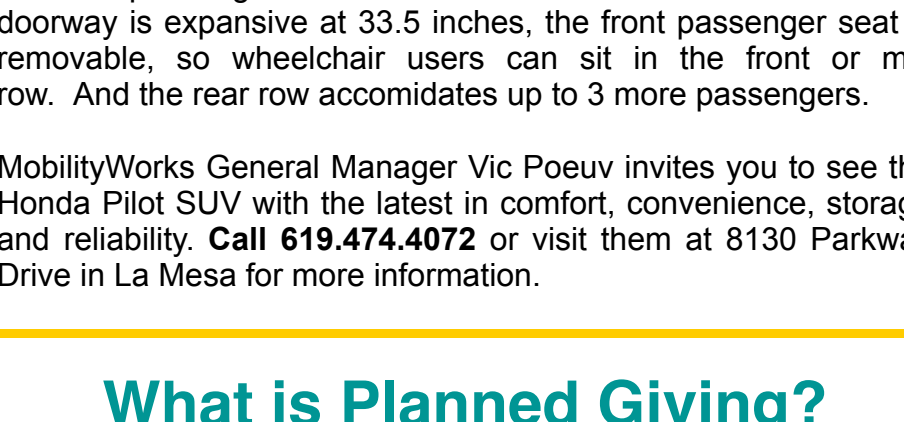

**Advances in Accessible Vehicles**

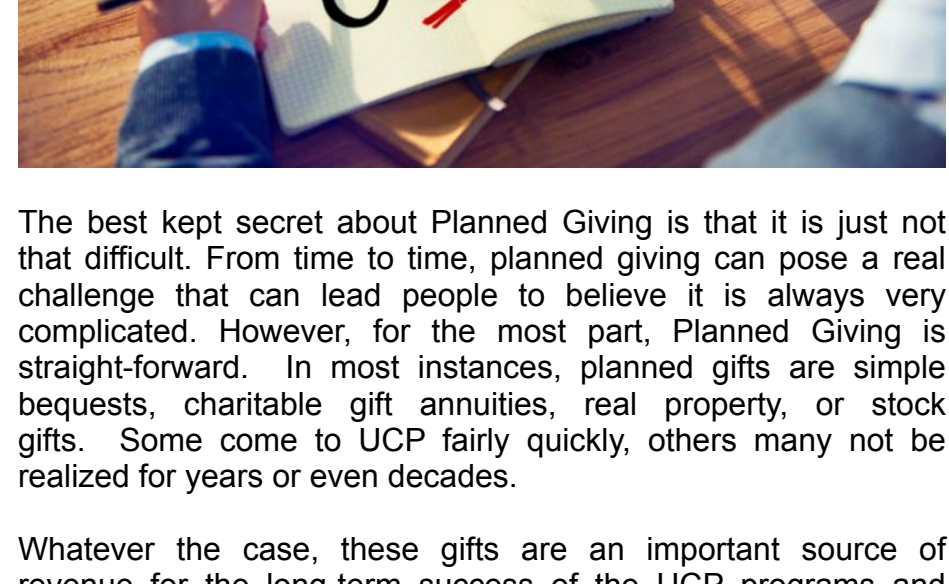


Wheelchair accessible vehicles play an important part of everyday life for people with disabilities and their families. Until recently, vans were the usual vehicle for these modifications. But now MobilityWorks in La Mesa has added the newest innovations in accessibility with the introduction of the Honda Pilot SUV featuring VMI Northstar E side-entry conversion.

This vehicle provides exceptional wheelchair maneuverability and room for passengers and drivers alike. The obstruction free side doorway is expansive at 33.5 inches, the front passenger seat is removable, so wheelchair users can sit in the front or mid row. And the rear row accommodates up to 3 more passengers.

Although it's still a few months away, the UCP staff is already making plans and lining up a great roster of food, fun, incentives and sponsors for this annual event on Mission Bay.

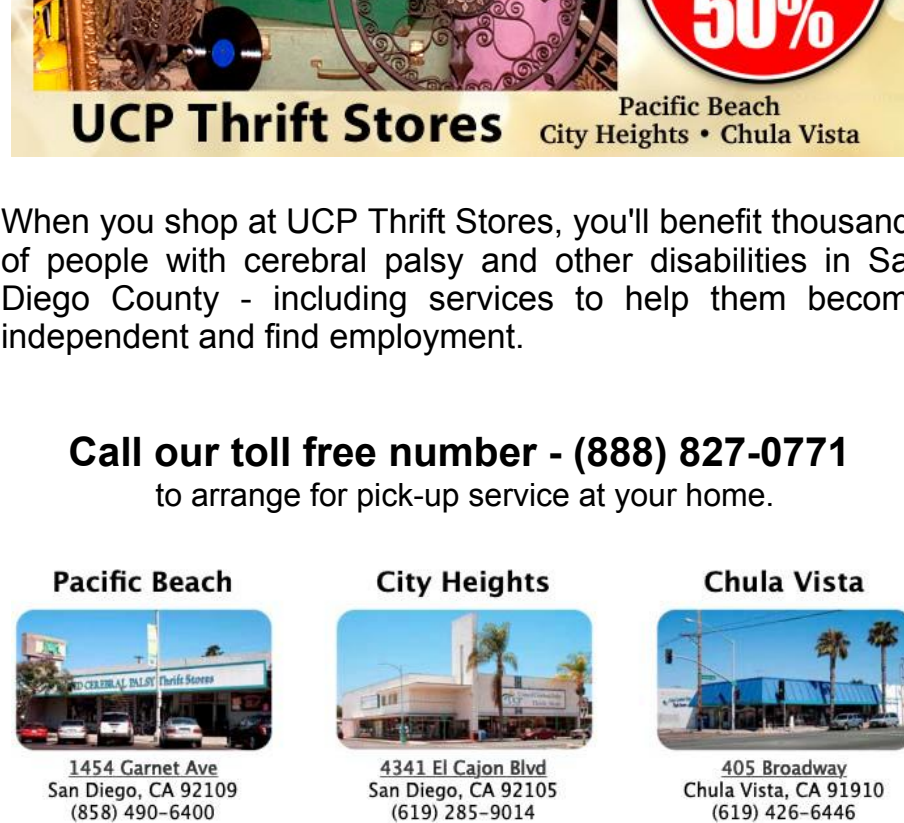
We would like to expand our signage along the walk at Mission Bay, and we are actively seeking Walk Sign Sponsors. It's really simple and inexpensive.

**7th Annual Regale in the Ranch**

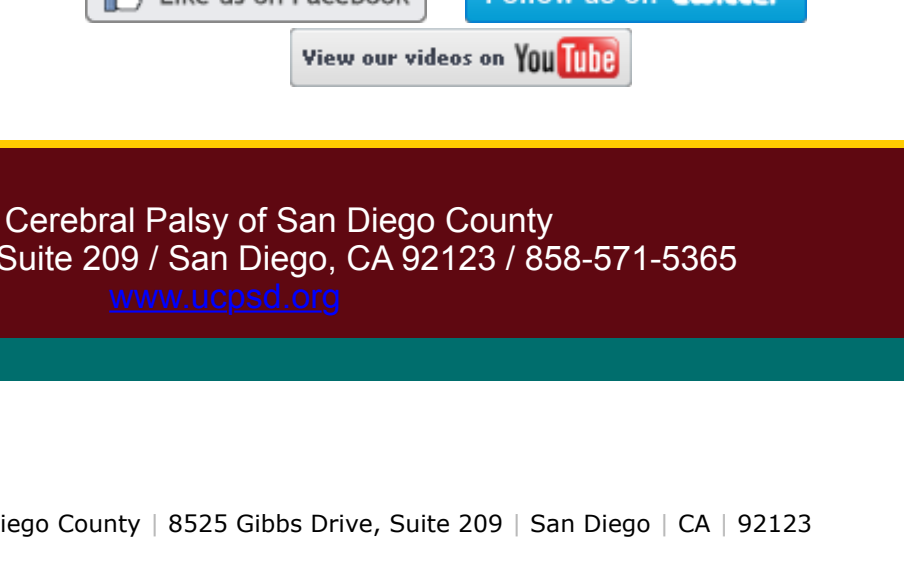
**Saturday, May 18th**
